### **STALL HOLDER AGREEMENT - Terms & Conditions**

*Please retain this Stall Holder Agreement - Terms & Conditions for your reference*

#### **1 WHO MAY REGISTER:**

- 1.1 Community groups; Sports teams; Marae; Tertiary; Businesses or other interested in having a stall at this event are required to complete & return a STALL HOLDER- Registration Form to the organising committee
- 1.2 The organising committee will select stall holder's from those returned registration forms

#### **2 STALL EQUIPMENT:**

- 2.1 Traditional kai (food) & hāngi stalls will have their Ezi-up provided
- 2.2 All other stalls will need to provide their own shelter / gazebo (but must not exceed 3m x 4m)
- 2.3 All Stall Holders are to provide their own tables / chairs / etc for use during the day
- 2.4 You are not permitted to play any music includes MP3, I-Pod; CD Player etc in your stall, as this may disturb other stall holders
- 2.5 All diesel, electric or petrol powered generators are not permitted on site

#### **3 STALL HOLDER SITES:**

- 3.1 All stall sites will be as allocated by Site Manager (no exceptions)
- 3.2 A standard site measures 3m x 4m. Should you require more space an additional stall site fee will be required
- 3.3 All rubbish / food scraps etc must be placed in the bins provided

#### **4 SET UP TIME:**

- 4.1 Stall Holders are required to be open by 9am
- 4.2 Service gate to site will be closed at 8.30am. No vehicular traffic will be permitted to access site after this time. (Emergency vehicles exempt)
- 4.3 ALL vehicles / trailers etc must be driven off site once set up is complete. No exceptions!

## 5 **MISCELLANEOUS INFORMATION:**

- 5.1 Hāngi stall holders are required to serve all hāngi meals in kono (*Traditional Flax Basket*). Please ensure that you have the required amount for your hāngi
- 5.2 All traditional kai stall holders selling kai moana (i.e.) fish, mussels, pipi, kina, etc must on demand produce receipts as proof of purchase
- 5.3 Kāwhia Kai Fest 2010 opens with karakia at 9am & concludes at 5pm with a closing karakia
- 5.4 The Kāwhia Kai Festival Site is a SMOKEFREE & ALCOHOL FREE venue at all times
- 5.5 Prizes will be awarded for the following: *Best Dressed Stall & Most Traditional Kai* (food)
- 5.6 Please ensure that you have enough float for your stall. Most Kāwhia businesses do not carry excess money or change
- 5.7 Your paid site entitles you to free entry for up to 4 (four) stall holders only. Extra persons & / or those not displaying official Stall Holder Wristbands will be required to pay admission fee

- 6.1 It is a condition of your entry to the Kāwhia Kai Fest 2010 that you read, understand & agree to the Terms & Conditions as outlined in this Stall Holder Agreement
